Abrupt elimination of the NB-EI Connect program

The abrupt elimination of the NB-EI Connect program is very disappointing, especially since the New Brunswick government does not seem to be planning at the same time to replace it with another financial assistance program. Consequently, the FNBFA denounces the pernicious effects that the closing of the program in question could have on access to post-secondary education, on the supposed GNB's desire to have public universities increase enrollment and on academic success.
